### **The Buena Park Police Department is Holding A DUI Checkpoint April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

Buena Park, Calif. – On April 29<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the Buena Park Police Department will conduct a driving under the influence (DUI) Checkpoint from 7pm to 3am at an undisclosed location within the city of Buena Park, CA.

DUI checkpoint locations are determined based on data showing incidents of impaired driving-related crashes. The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints are to promote public safety by taking suspected impaired drivers off the road.

“Impaired drivers put others on the road at significant risk,” Sgt. J. Shaddow said. “Any prevention measures that reduce the number of impaired drivers on our roads significantly improves traffic safety.”

The Buena Park Police Department reminds the public that impaired driving is not just from alcohol. Some prescription medications and over-the-counter drugs may interfere with driving. While medicinal and recreational marijuana are legal, driving under the influence of marijuana is illegal.

Drivers charged with a first-time DUI face an average of \$13,500 in fines and penalties, as well as a suspended license.
