REPORT OF ARMED SUBJECT IN STREET

Suspect taken into custody after barricading himself in an apartment

BUENA PARK, Calif. — On Wednesday 6/21/17 at approximately 6:15pm, officers from the Buena Park Police Department responded to the area of Crescent Avenue and Grand Avenue regarding reports of a man walking in the street armed with a handgun. As officers arrived, a subject fled on foot and entered an apartment in the 7600 block of Fillmore Drive. Officers quickly contained the area, and evacuated nearby residents. The suspect barricaded himself in a bedroom and would not respond to numerous communication attempts by the officers. At about 7:30pm, officers made entry into the apartment and located the suspect hiding in the bedroom. After refusing several commands to surrender, a police K-9 was deployed, and the suspect was taken into custody. A replica handgun was found nearby. The suspect was taken to a local hospital for treatment of minor injuries. At this time, the connection between the suspect and the apartment is unclear, and there were no injuries to any residents in the area.

The suspect was identified as Curtis Devin LAMONT, 23 years of age, from Buena Park. At this time, the charges against him include resisting/obstructing a peace officer, drug possession, and a parole violation.
